Rise Against Hunger Event

On April 28, Beacon Christian School hosted a Rise Against Hunger event. Rise Against Hunger is an organization trying to reduce malnourishment in poverty-stricken countries—many in Africa and Asia. We had to raise over \$5000 to host the event, and many generous donors responded to a fundraising campaign organized by Hadley Bergamo. At the event, the students, teachers, and volunteers packaged over 10,000 meal packets, each designed to feed six people. Many of these packets will be distributed to impoverished school children, meaning that education is also being encouraged.
